BB2	Ensure segregation of waste at source	1. Waste segregation at source is practiced in residential and commercial areas. 2. Households where segregated waste is not provided are given guidance on segregation of dry and wet waste. 3. Approx. 400000 pairs of dust bins (green dustbin for wet waste and blue dustbin for dry waste storage) is distributed to each households and commercial shops previously. 4. Commercial shops are fined for providing the mixed waste. 5. IEC material explaining the lifecycle of waste and harmful impact of untreated waste on human life shall be printed and circulate in each household. 6.
